About the Stroll & Roll

September 27, 2015

Our first Guide Dog Foundation Stroll & Roll was such a success, we're happy to announce our second annual combination bike-a-thon and dog walk!

Bike riders will leave from The Rinx at Hidden Pond Park in Hauppauge. The Suffolk Bicycle Riders Association will once again plan fun and exciting routes through central Long Island, ranging from flat terrains for casual riders to challenging courses for experienced bikers.

Back by popular demand – a family-friendly 3-mile ride! Our other rides go from 10 miles and up to a challenging 75 miles. Depending on the ride's length, riders will tour Ronkonkoma, Holtsville, Yaphank, Rocky Point, and Wading River.

The 3-, 10-, 22-, and 32-mile tours are escorted by volunteer marshals from the Suffolk Bicycle Riders Association (SBRA). The 52- and 75-mile tours will be unescorted; participants ride at their own pace using the route cue sheets provided.

If you'd rather "stroll" than "roll," we have just the thing for you. Take an easy hike through Hidden Pond Park on our family-friendly 2-mile dog walk. Don't worry – you don't have to walk with a dog. Just pack up the kids or bring a few friends and saunter around the park.

Helmets are required for all riders.

Emergency support vehicles (SAG) can assist riders with difficulties. Rest/water/food stops are available along the routes.
