- Drivers Please Treat Bicyclists With Respect!
 Bicyclists are traffic and have the legal right to ride on the road.
- Pay attention to bicyclists and don't drive distracted.
- Pass only when necessary, slow down and give 3 feet of space.
- Let bicyclists clear intersections before making right turns.
- When turning left or entering a roadway, yield right of way to oncoming bicyclists as you would to any driver.

Keeping our roads safe is a SHARED RESPONSIBILITY.

Remember, someone you care about rides a bike. Don't turn your drive into a tragedy.


